*Rabban Gamaliel the son of Rabbi Yehudah haNasi said: "Let all who work for the community do so out of pure motives for then the merit of their parents will sustain them and their righteousness will endure forever." (Pirkei Avot 2:2)*

Lynne and Arnie Gordon have frequently invoked their parents' examples in explaining their own exemplary dedication to Jewish community service. Having known all four of their parents, I can attest that their loving acknowledgment is well placed.

Lynne and Arnie's own distinguished commitment began at Cornell University's kosher dining hall where, sure enough, Arnie was foreshadowing greater things to come as dining hall president.
