## **A YEAR TO REMEMBER OR A YEAR TO FORGET?**

2020 seemed to be a year full of promises for a new President of CSOI. How could you not be optimistic about a year that shared the number associated with perfect vision? But things changed rapidly as our understanding of COVID-19 developed. Instead of clarity, uncertainty prevailed as we faced unemployment, travel challenges, disruptions in supply chains, isolation from friends and families, and closures. While we might like to forget the problems of 2020, I believe that would be a mistake. Instead, we need to reflect on the challenges that we faced and take time to recall our accomplishments.

CSOI rose to the occasion during the most challenging moments of the pandemic. While the physical plant was closed to the public in accordance with governmental regulations, the Congregation, itself, never stopped providing full services. The introduction of Zoom technology safely re-opened the door and invited congregants to stay tuned. CSOI took full advantage of video conferencing by scheduling daily religious and educational experiences for adults, telephone and Zoom classes for our Nursery and elementary school children, personal outreach to congregants, assistance to families in need, officiation at life-cycle functions, and on-going communications. Under the leadership of Rabbi Ginsburg, Cantor Weiss, Harriet Gefen, and the Board of Trustees, we learned that we could not just be reactive, but proactive as well. Within a few short months, we re-introduced our Shabbat morning service using the length and breadth of our beautiful sanctuary to ensure Distancing, Masking and Cleanliness. We re-opened our on-premises Ganoni pre-school and Sisterhood has been attracting participants in a variety of Zoom presentations.

In the summer months, we flourished as we assembled safely both indoors and outdoors. This multi-tracked approach designed to attract all our congregants worked well as we organized our seating and services during the High Holidays. Amazingly, hundreds of families attended these services with a sense of comfort and safety. Consequently, our resolve to focus our attention to detail has turned uncertainty and helplessness into hope and good fortune. During the painfully difficult months of the pandemic, I resolved to try to stay positive - not because I was burying my head in the sand. Rather, I wanted to focus my energy on what is good and not let all the negative consume my life. To date, not a single congregant of CSOI has contracted the COVID virus by attending one of our functions.

As my first year as President ends, I would like to review the lessons learned and what our challenges might mean for our future.

A review of our Operating Budget demonstrates our knowledge and skills to successfully manage our financial account by being proactive and instituting good fiscal protocols. We receive income from the rental of the building to our Yeshiva, IPM and assorted organizations. To supplement our operating expenses, we were successful in the PPP (Payment Protection Program) loan process. Moreover, we have received numerous grants. And, we are optimistic that our Ganoni program and the return of catering services will further help us to offset our costs. Be assured that we are ever diligent in reviewing our expenses. We recently trimmed our staff resulting in a savings of salary payments. Finally, we have created a CSOI Financial Committee that oversees our institutional investments that we have acquired through the sale of property to IPM.

We have strengthened the structure and routines of several of our Committees. To name a few, The Strategic Planning Committee under the leadership of Arnold Gordon, past president, is actively exploring two important initiatives. First, the B'Yachad Alliance has been formed to identify the resources and highlight the resourcefulness of the Conservative Synagogues in our community. The presentation "Love, Laughter and Latkes: The Golden Age of the Catskills" is just the beginning of meaningful alliance between the conservative synagogues. Second, the Strategic Planning Committee is conducting an outreach to our membership to gather thoughts and opinions about the future direction of CSOI. Specifically, the announcement by Rabbi Ginsburg of his retirement in July 2022 requires us to begin the process of not only finding our new Rabbi but also to review our constitution. Indeed, the work of the Ritual Committee under the leadership of Marcel Buchsbaum has been integral in responding to the COVID pandemic. No doubt, the Ritual Committee will take the lead in the search for our new Rabbi. The Security Committee under the leadership of Warren Prosky is presently in the process of reviewing our security protocols with the intention of distributing best practices guidelines to our membership in the event of an incident. This is no simple matter as daily accounts in the news indicates the importance of planning and preparing for a worst-case scenario. In addition, the Security Committee is actively engaged in security grant writing, hardening of the synagogue facility and monitoring/surveillance of activities that often provides the security for hundreds of adults and children.

In closing, I extend my thanks to the Board of Trustees. Although, the Trustees are scheduled to meet but once a month, the real work is being done on several days and evenings throughout the month. I am indebted to the knowledge, skills, and commitment of the Trustees, and of course, the Membership for making the first year a success.

Festival Musaph service with references to Shavuot in the festival Musaph Amidah. Ayn Kelohenu. Aleinu. Adon Olam.

#### Monday Afternoon, May 17

Recite the festival Minchah service with references to Shavuot in the festival Amidah

### SECOND DAY

#### Monday Evening, May 17

Light candles concluding the first blessing with "...l'hadlik ner shel Yom Tov" followed by the second blessing concluding with "...shehechyanu v'kiyemanu v'higianu lazman hazeh"




